An Enrolled Agent (EA) is an individual designation by the Internal Revenue Service, a federally-authorized tax practitioner who has technical expertise in the field of taxation and can legally represent taxpayers before all administrative levels of the Internal Revenue Service for all audits and/or appeals.Only Enrolled Agents, attorneys, and CPAs may legally represent taxpayers before the IRS.

Unlike CPAs, who may or may not provide tax services, IRS Enrolled Agents specialize in taxation. Enrolled Agents advise, represent, and prepare tax returns for a variety of clients. Â The status identifies these individuals to the client as specialists and ensures that the Enrolled Tax Agent has kept up to date on the latest tax law changes. This brings you more business and income. Â The right to represent taxpayers before the IRS is given only to selected groups of individuals.

How to become an Enrolled Agent?
